But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. - 2 Peter 3:8

I need to remember both viewpoints. My Navajo friends get a lot of things right; including not being in such a rush. There is a lesson in that. A lesson I learned on our first trip there nearly 20 years ago. Work hard, serve the Lord, worship, and pray. In Navajo time.

I know that God does not see time as we do. Peter makes that clear that “with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.” I’m thinking that our God must laugh at us and our impatience. As it says in Proverbs, “The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps.”
